Homework

We are expecting that children complete the following homework each week:

Reading - 5 minutes Daily

Reading every day and written in children's reading record. This can be a coloured book or a reading for pleasure book from home.

Statutory Spellings – 2x per week

Lists sent out each half term and to be practised in Homework books. These are statutory spellings for the age group (Y2 or Y3) and need to be learnt by heart by the end of the academic year.

TTRS or Numbots - 5 minutes Daily

Access TTRS on Jamming and Garage to boost standings in the weekly competitions or Numbots to develop number knowledge.

Year 2 – CGP SATs Book – Pages set each week.Set on a Friday and to be returned the following Thursday.

Year 3 - Maths White Rose Book – Pages set each week.Set on a Friday and to be returned the following Thursday.

Homework is to ensure that children have a great foundation to all their learning and can apply this in school. We really appreciate the time taken to support your child at home and can really see the difference it makes to your child's progress.

Maths

We are starting our maths
