In PSHE, we will be exploring the theme 'Celebrating Differences'. We will be looking at how we can become anti-bullying ambassadors.

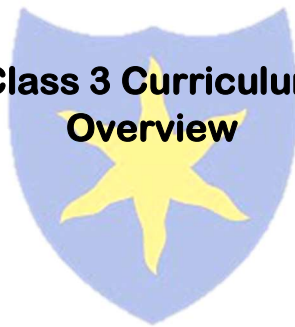


D.T.

Science

We are learning about Materials: Properties and Changes. We will be investigating reversible and irreversible changes.



Computing
