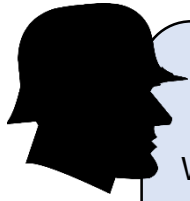
Make an air raid shelter / Anderson shelter. Think about which materials would be best to use.

In Art, we will be creating our own portraits using mixed media. We will develop our understanding of different mediums.

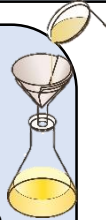
## PSHE

In Music, we will be exploring new vocabulary such as volume, pitch and rhythm and creating new songs.

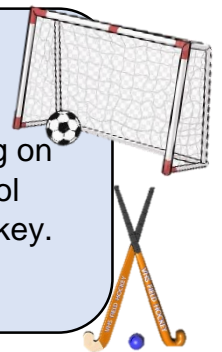
## French
