In D.T. we will be creating motor electrical Doodler systems using our Science knowledge of circuits.

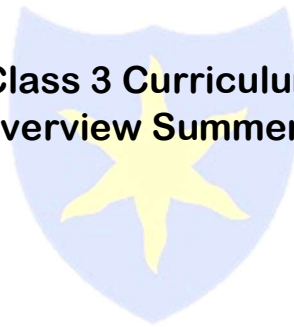
French

PSHE
