
PACKED LUNCHES

THIS WEEK

We have been studying Ancient and Modern Egypt in Falcons. In art, we have designed and modelled our own Canopic jars to hold the innards of mummified Egyptians. The lids of the jars were the likenesses of four gods: Hapi, who had the head of a baboon; Duamutef, with the head of a jackal; Qebehsenuf, who had the head of a falcon; and Imsety, who had a human head.

The children are working carefully and with super detail. The next step is to paint them and add hieroglyphs.

Autism Awareness Day


