We are delighted to have been able to secure a weekly slot at the newly refurbished Wellness Centre (formally the Hydro) in Harrogate for the Summer Term. This will take place on a Thursday afternoon during school hours.

As you may be aware swimming provision is a statutory requirement of the PE National Curriculum that requires that by the end of Y6 children can:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.

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- Children may on occasions be asked to bring clean clothing or pyjamas to wear for water safety lessons. This should be light weight clothing which can be removed easily and worn over the top

As you may be aware swimming provision is a statutory requirement of the PE National Curriculum that requires that by the end of Y6 children can:

- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]

The first swimming lesson of the summer term will take place on the afternoon of Thursday 11th April 2024 with the final session for the term being Thursday 11th July 2024. Children will be taken to and from the Wellness Centre by coach.
